REASONS FOR GOING SOLAR

Choosing an installer (what certifications to look for)

- Essential requirements:
 - SAPVIA accreditation
 - Electrical contractor (WC and IE numbers) Dept of Labour letter
 - All risk contractor's insurance
- Additional benfecial accreditations:
 - CSD registration
 - CIDB registration

City of Cape Town requirements

- From 1 October 2023 all battery back-up systems need to be registered with City of Cape Town
- Homeowner's responsibility to ensure solar and battery back-up system is registered
- You can only install a system that is on the City of Cape Town's approved inverter list
- SSEG Application process going online in March 2024
- Engineer inspection and sign off mandatory
- COC by an electrical contractor registered with Department of Labour and ECB
- Permission to install and reference number



Sizing your system

- Before purchasing a system consult with an expert to carry out a free site assessment and energy audit
- Discuss what you want to achieve by installing a system
- Look at your budget and energy usage
- Don't be fooled by cheap options
- Every home / business is a unique site and must be treated as such - there is no one size fits all system

Maintenance and Monitoring

- Industry standard to check and clean panels every 6 (six) months
- Post installation Service Level Agreement peace of mind
- Factors that hamper solar panel performance:
 - Wind / Rain / Dust / Birds & Other Wildlife
- Protect your solar investment and keep warranties valid only use reputable company to clean, maintain and service your system
- Remote monitoring of your system's performance and electricity savings via the App

Feeding back to the grid

- City of Cape Town's Cash for Power incentive - residents can feed electricity back to the grid
- Specialised meters currently cost R12 000 but new cheaper meters in testing phase
- Feed-in tariff for 2024 is 87c/kWh as approved by NERSA and COCT offers an additional incentive of 25c/kWh
- Application process still in testing phase
